GROUP USE OF FACILITIES POLICY

Porcupine Ski Runners (PSR) supports the use of our facilities by groups as a means of raising the profile of winter sports such as cross country skiing, snowshoeing and our club.

Groups wishing to use the facilities must contact the person in charge of group bookings and fill out a *Use of Facilities form*. All groups must abide by the rules and expectations as outlined in this policy.

Rules and Expectations

1. Payment for use of facilities must be attached to the *Use of Facilities form*. (cheques are made payable to Porcupine Ski Runners)
2. It is the responsibility of those in charge of the group to plan for adequate supervision to ensure the safety of every member of the group.
3. The person(s) planning the activity should be aware of the level of challenge of each of our trails. The Red, Junior Olympic and Olympic trails are technically and physically demanding and should be skied only by competent skiers, especially in fast and icy conditions. The Yellow and Loppet trails while not technically difficult are long and require that the skier be suitably conditioned and equipped.
4. Skiers should know the following:
 - How to read all trail signs
 - To stay on the trails at all times and ski only in the direction indicated by the trail sign.
 - To dress properly for the weather conditions
 - To not walk on the track. If it is necessary to remove skis and walk, then walk along the side of the trail
 - To not litter the trails
5. Porcupine Ski Runners is run by volunteers. Please clean up your own mess be it from waxing or lunch.
6. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the premises. Smoking in general is discouraged and smoking is not permitted in any of the club's buildings.
7. Porcupine Ski Runners is not responsible for articles left unattended during your use of the facilities.
8. The applicant will be responsible for any and all damage or unusual "wear and tear" on PSR property arising out of use under their permit.
9. Porcupine Ski Runners reserves the right to cancel any permit at any time.
10. The applicant shall be responsible for the enforcement of the regulations listed herein.
