

## PORCUPINE SKI RUNNERS

  - Chalet:** Located near the top left.
  - Sprint Trails:** Located near the 'START' point.
  - Gold Centre:** A building or area near the bottom left.
  - To: Olympic Loop:** A trail branch near the bottom left.
  - To bypass Jr Olympic Hill:** A trail branch near junction M.

**Legend:**

- Lighted Trail: Single line with a small 'i' icon.
- Junction ID: e.g. A
- Crossing - Caution: Circle with a diagonal line.
- Road or Highway: Double line.
- Snowmobile Trail: Double line with a snowmobile icon.

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
